Description:

This product softens and gets rid of tree resin, bug residue, and birdshot. Stubborn residue is broken down by sophisticated surfactants.

• The product can be used straight away and doesn't need to be diluted.

Instructions:

- 1. Spray the solution onto the area with bug residue or bird droppings that needs cleaning.
- 2. Allow it to sit for 2-3 minutes to dissolve the stains.
- 3. Wipe the area with a clean towel.
- 4. Finally, rinse thoroughly with clean water.
